OVERVIEW

Democrats Serve helps public service Democrats run for office and win. We're the only organization focused on recruiting, training, and supporting Democrats with experience serving their communities in government, including first responders, firefighters, social workers, police officers, prosecutors, judges, public defenders, and more.

PURPOSE

Democrats with professional public service backgrounds connect with persuadable Democrats and independent voters uniquely due to their focused experience serving the public and strengthening their communities. Public service Democrats know what it takes to successfully navigate the business of government, more often than not making for moderate candidacies. This is excellent news given that, on average, House elections favor moderate candidates (*University of Chicago Press*, 1/18/2021).

However, public service Democrats often fall short because they do not possess personal wealth or lack the built-in fundraising network of many non-working class candidates. And since public service Democrats are more likely to be moderate candidates, the cost of running creates a steeper hill to climb than those who are more ideologically extreme; when the cost of running for office increases, the candidates contesting are more likely to be ideologically extreme because their net policy payoffs from running are higher than those of moderate candidates (*Annual Review of Political Science*, 1/18/2021).

The bottom line: Public service Democrats make for high-quality candidates and moderate candidacies. But they're unlikely to run without proper infrastructure, resources, strategic counsel, and inside-and-outside support.

That's where Democrats Serve plays a pivotal role.

The organization's activities include:

- Recruiting and training candidates at the federal, state, county, and municipal levels;
- Delivering logistical support and strategic guidance to put candidates in competitive positions;
- **Providing access** to donors for financial aid;
- Making direct contributions to candidates; and
- Supporting candidates through independent expenditure activity.

Frame Strategies

GOALS (2023-24)

For the 2023-24 election cycle, the organization's goals are as follows:

- 1 Take back the House Majority.
- (2) Target key Senate and statewide races critical to chamber control and peaceful power transfer.
- **3** Combat the anti-public safety, public service, and working-class tag that Republicans are slapping Democrats with nationwide.

TENETS

The following are principles we'll use to guide our activities:

- **Focus on competitive House Districts.** Our House-related efforts will focus mainly on 70 competitive districts, including the 18 Republican-held where Biden won in 2020.
- Position electable Democrats to win above all else. Research is clear: General Election voters aren't interested in extremist candidates, especially in House races. Therefore, we prioritize supporting electable Democrats through Primary Election independent expenditure activities who are strong, moderate, and electable.
- Candidate quality and electability are paramount in resource allocation decisions. The organization will not rush to provide financial support to candidates if doing so doesn't help achieve its goals or if the race is unwinnable.
- Mercenary over missionary in service of helping Democrats win. We will function as a resource for Democrats and our partner organizations to help achieve our goals, including but not limited to assisting extremist Republicans to win primary elections where doing so better positions the Democrat to succeed in a General Election.

INVESTMENT

For our independent expenditure supporting Gabe Amo's congressional bid in Rhode Island's 1st District, we aim for a total budget of \$750,000. This will help ensure Gabe's candidacy is supported with sufficient resources and air cover needed to win on Tuesday, September 5, 2023.
